Item #3 New Business

a. Review of Conceptual Design by Alex Eickoff- all present has had a chance to review the first draft of the art mural for the downtown Hub. Recommendations after discussion were given to Sam to relay to the artist. Sam suggested another meeting before the next regular monthly meeting may be needed to go forward after the artist reviews the suggestions and submits a  $2^{nd}$  draft.

b. Commitment to contract: Sam included in the packets the contract with revisions for committee to review.

4. Officer Reports: Sarah introduced the committee to the textile artist and writer Sandra Scott-Revelle, of KCMO. Her textile art tells stories of slaves and escaping slavery by the Underground Railroad. She perhaps can be considered in the future for a commissioned piece of art specific to Osawatomie and Bleeding Kansas and perhaps a large outdoor mural can be made. She is currently reading on John Brown to get more familiar with the history here.

Sarah also suggested an art competition with scrap wood, similar to pieces seen on trails in Overland Park. Discussion ensued with Phyllis Sharp who represents the John Brown State Historical Site; she is asking for help and support for an art project of some kind during the time of the Freedom Festival September 16th/17th. The commission indicated support for such a project.

Nicole suggested also an emphasis on the native American history of this area for an art project in the future.

Item #4: Staff Reports: Sam asked the commission to come up with a Strategic Plan with short, mid, and long-term goals for public art works and projects, and we will discuss them at the regular August meeting. Reference was made to the city of Lawrence, KS and their comprehensive strategic plan. It can be found online with a Google search, and members were encouraged to seek that and others out.

A lengthy discussion of funding ensued, with suggestions such as fundraisers, asking for donations, seeking grants and other outside sources as well as funding from city budget.
