

RESOLUTION NO. 1037

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF BG CONSULTANTS FOR THE AWARD OF ONE CONTRACT FOR 18TH ST, MAIN STREET TERRACE AN WALNUT FROM 4TH TO 6TH STREET AND ONE CONTRACT FOR A STREET RESURFACING PROJECT ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS

WHEREAS, the council approved a property tax rate increase from 63.236 to 80.000 mills for the 2022 fiscal year by Resolution 918; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Osawatomie also voted in favor of a ½ cent sales tax also dedicated to street projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution 931 authorizing its City Engineer to draft plans for 18th Street, Main Street Terrace and Walnut from 4th to 6th; and

WHEREAS, the city issued in accordance with its financial policies, RFPs for reconstruction of certain streets as well as resurfacing certain other streets; and

WHEREAS, city staff has held the public bid opening, opened those bids, and performed a thorough evaluation of each bid; and

WHEREAS, the City received three (3) bids for the reconstruction work and four (4) bids for the resurfacing work; and

WHEREAS, bidders for the reconstruction work were: Killough Construction, Kansas Heavy Construction and Orr/Wyatt Streetscapes; and

WHEREAS, bidders for the resurfacing work were: McAnany Construction, Barkley Asphalt, Superior Bowen, and Killough Construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OSAWATOMIE, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: The Governing Body hereby accepts the recommendation of its City Engineer, BG Consultants with regard to the awarding of the contract for reconstruction of 18th Street, Main Street Terrace and Walnut from 4th to 6th to Killough Construction and awards the asphalt option along with the realignment of the intersection at 4th and Walnut in the amount of: \$1,734,521.07.

SECTION TWO: The Governing Body hereby accepts the recommendation of its City Engineer, BG Consultants with regard to the awarding of the contract for the resurfacing of 12th Street from Pacific to South Street, 7th Street from the Overpass to Main Street, Slayman Heights, and 11th Street from Main to approximately the Ozone to McAnany Construction in the amount of \$217,988.75.

SECTION THREE: The Governing Body understands that with the resurfacing project, the quantities utilized to generate the contract value are estimated and that the city will only pay for actual quantities placed. It authorizes the City Manager or Deputy City Manager to approve up to \$20,000 in overages, should the need arise.

SECTION FOUR: The Governing Body hereby directs city staff to make every effort to minimize construction costs and schedule with regard to these projects and authorizes city staff to execute the construction agreements on its behalf.
