

RESOLUTION NO. 1043

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND ALLOCATING ARPA
DOLLARS FOR SPECIFIC USES IN THE CITY'S 2022 BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the City of Osawatomie was awarded \$183,899 in ARPA grant dollars from Miami County government; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the County was to assist local communities' economic development opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Osawatomie has decided that it is prudent and responsible to identify the intended uses and purposes of these dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OSAWATOMIE, KANSAS:
