RESOLUTION NO. 973

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO APPLY FOR A KDOT COST SHARE PROGRAM GRANT TO ASSIST IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE $6^{\rm TH}$ STREET PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Osawatomie has identified certain streets to be rebuilt during the 2023 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the city council adopted a capital improvement plan that identified 6th Street from the northern city limit to the southern city limit for replacement; and

WHEREAS, the city council recognizes the importance of applying for, and obtaining grants such as this to help minimize the financial impact to the citizens of Osawatomie; and

WHEREAS, the City of Osawatomie, Kansas is a legal governmental entity as provided by the laws of the State of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the city intends to submit an application for assistance from the Cost Share Program from the Kansas Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OSAWATOMIE, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: The Governing Body of Osawatomie, Kansas hereby directs city staff to apply for a KDOT Cost Share Program Grant that will provide the city with up to \$1,000,000 of the costs needed to replace 6th Street.

SECTION TWO: The Governing Body of Osawatomie, Kansas hereby directs city staff to provide a detailed budget in the coming months for the project and keep the City Council apprised of the grant process.
