Re: Meeting with Northland property owners and residents

As you may be aware, there has been a petition delivered to the City from Northland property owners and residents requesting the deannexation of your property. This means your property would no longer be a part of the City of Osawatomie. The City Council will take formal action on this request at their September 8, 2022 meeting. There are ramifications, that are both positive and negative, should the City Council deem it appropriate to deannex this area. I've asked, and the City Council has granted me the opportunity to meet with all of the *Northland property owners and residents on September 1, 2022 at Memorial Hall, 411 11th Street, Osawatomie, KS 64064.*

This meeting will provide the latest information that we have in regards to,

- potential sanitary sewer connections and costs.
- potential transfer of the electric utility to the City of Osawatomie.
- future plans for street maintenance and repairs.
- planned development of a bike trail to the west of the area.
- potential change in trash/recycling and bulky-item services.
- potential reduction in property tax payments by property owners if the area were deannexed.
