FACILITY RENTALS



Q john brown statue osawatomie

The life-size statue of abolitionist John Brown in John Brown Memorial Park was erected in 1935, 25 years after the dedication of the park by President Theodore Roosevelt. The statue was created by George Fite Waters and is one of only two remaining public pieces created by the artist. The other is a life-size statue of Abraham Lincoln in Portland, Oregon.
