TEMP MAIN ST DETOUR

City of Osawatomie Public Works officials have announced an upcoming TEMPORARY closure of Main Street between 7th and 12th for necessary work beginning on August 2nd, 2023.

This closure is expected to last two to three weeks, weather permitting, and is essential to connect the new storm sewer for Brown Avenue into the existing storm sewer on Main Street. During this work, the affected area will be completely closed to all traffic. Since this is part of the Brown Avenue project, Brown Avenue from 7th Street to 12th Street will also be closed to through traffic at the same time. We ask that you do not travel around the barricades during this work. Barricades on 7th Street and 12th Street will be adjusted to allow use of those streets without going around barricades.

NEWS AND REMINDERS

CONCRETE WORK - WALNUT

Installation of new concrete curb, gutter, and driveway approaches for Walnut Avenue (between 4th and 6th Streets) began on 7/24/2023. Please have all vehicles removed from the street and driveways no later than 6 am each day until concrete is complete. The curb and gutter will be laid using a machine and move quickly through the project. Any vehicles still on the street will be towed at owner's expense. The concrete contractor will follow behind the machine to begin work on the driveway approaches. The contractor has estimated that they will be able to install all driveway approaches within 2-3 days after curb and gutter is completely installed. Driveways will be completely INACCESSIBLE while the concrete cures. Please be sure to move vehicles out of garages/driveways if you will need access to them during this time.
