In 2021, Osawatomie undertook our biggest planning effort in decades with the OZ Commons Downtown Redevelopment Plan. This planning effort was a great success thanks to strong public support. The plan has made many positive impacts in Osawatomie. Re-imagining two downtown lots was part of the first phase of that project. Draft renderings based upon community input were included in the final recommendations presented to City Council in October of that year. After this second phase of planning and design work is complete, the lots will begin a new chapter as 'The Hub,' a central gathering place where visitors and residents can:
