

## PRE-CONSTRUCTION ON BROWN AVENUE

The full-depth reconstruction of Brown Avenue from 7th to 12th was awarded to Killough Construction of Ottawa, Kansas, at the April 27th, 2023, meeting of City Council. Construction mobilization for the project is estimated to begin in late June, depending on weather and prior completion of the Walnut Avenue project. Pre-construction activities along Brown Avenue kicked off this week as utility relocates and other prep work officially got underway. Residents will see an increase in locate flags in their yards over the next several weeks as critical infrastructure is marked, including gas lines, water lines, and buried cables.


## MAIN ST TERRACE - ROAD CLOSED
