

ORDINANCE NUMBER 3795

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 3783 OF THE CITY OF OSAWATOMIE, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3783 was passed by the governing body of the City of Osawatomie on July 9, 2020 requiring the wearing of masks or other face coverings in public spaces; and

WHEREAS, as of this date COVID-19 cases in Miami County have declined and there is no longer an immediate danger to the health and safety of the residents of Osawatomie; and

WHEREAS, the City of Osawatomie must remain flexible to account for the evolving nature and scope of the unprecedented public health emergency posed by COVID-19; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OS OSAWATOMIE, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance 3783 of the City is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it is passed and approved by the City Council and published one time in the official City newspaper.
